HLC NOTES: SPA 3 Homeless Innovations

- Provide opportunities for law enforcement to continue promoting existing best practices and innovations such as **Homeless Outreach Service Team (HOST)** and **Homeless Assistance Liaison Officer Program (HALO)** programs that reposition law enforcement as a homelessness first responder.
- In partnership with United Way's Everyone In Campaign, co-develop and launch a **localized public awareness campaign and associated toolkit** that features in-person presentations, messaging, informational materials, policy positions, original video content etc., possibly around LA-HOP, how to increase awareness around?

- 5) If time permits, solicit new ideas or policy recommendations
 - a) ONE - 605 and Ramona encampment on Caltrans property...need to be educated and engaged.
 - b) TWO - fund local regional city outreach coordinator that is well connected to law enforcement
