**Impact Highlights**

- 1) New **SGVC website** ([www.sgvc.org](http://www.sgvc.org)) will publicly launch in late August. An internal draft of the website will be available to SGVC staff and Board the first week of August, followed by a public rollout. The website will feature SPA 3-specific resources including:
  - *Dedicated webpages* to: the SPA 3 Homeless Leadership Committee; video production featuring original content; SGV City Homelessness Plans; and communications and advocacy resources for various stakeholders (i.e. community members, service providers, civic leaders, etc.)
  - Calendars for *Technical Assistance & Funding Schedules* and *SGV City Council Meetings*;
  - *Online Data Mapping Platform* which will offer: mapping, homeless count data, homeless investments, housing inventory, related services, volunteer opportunities, etc.
- 2) Twice convened SGVC Subcommittees (**Data & Evaluation; Health; Education & Workforce Development; and Law Enforcement**) to: 1) Collectively identify top 3 programmatic/policy recommendations for engagement (will also be shared at next HLC meeting) and 2) Develop outreach strategies to expand Subcommittees and ultimately Consortium.
- 3) **SGVC Social Media** efforts resulting in: Successful authorization from Facebook's new security feature to run political or "issues based" ads. Moreover, Since taking over social in February, we've grown the number of page likes (followers) from 698 to 1,109 likes and posts are reaching around 15,085 people per week.
- 4) Engaged Consortium members in collective "**Calls to Action**" regarding:
  - Galvanizing SGVC member and public support for City Homelessness Plans at the May Board of Supervisors meeting.
- 5) Convened **SPA 3 Homeless Leadership Committee (HLC)** monthly to strategize and discuss:
  - SGVC documents: TA & Funding Schedule; City Council Meeting Calendar; SGVC Homeless Innovations Summary; SGVC Organizational Chart.
  - Decision making protocol and agreements for organizational representatives
  - Presentation topics for monthly Consortium meetings
  - New HLC meeting time.
- 6) **Educate on the SGVC**, its current work, initiatives, partnerships and ways to get involved.
