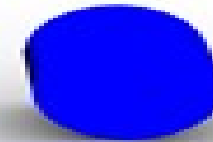

SGVCOG HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION



- The SGVCOG's role in the Region
 - A joint powers authority
 - 30 cities,
 - 3 Los Angeles County Supervisorial Districts,
 - 3 Municipal Water Districts
 - A regional voice for its member agencies
 - Works to improve the quality of life for the more than 2 million residents living in the San Gabriel Valley.
 - Works on issues of importance: transportation, housing, homelessness, economic development, the environment, and water, addressing these regionally.

SGVCOG HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION

- **Homelessness Committee**
 - The SGVCOG Homelessness Committee studies problems, programs, and other matters which pertain to the regional issues homelessness and provides policy direction to the SGVCOG Governing Board.
 - Fourth Thursday of each month at 12:30 PM at the Monrovia Public Library (312 S. Myrtle Ave; Monrovia, CA).
 - Membership on the Homelessness Committee is open to Governing Board Delegates, Governing Board Alternates, City Managers or City staff.
 - Meetings are open to the public and receive public comment

SGVCOG HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION

The SGVCOG's Role in the Cities' Homeless Planning Processes

- Ensures that all the basic requirements of the County are met
- Regional concerns identified by the COG and the cities
- Hire and manage the work of the consultant
 - Monitor community input meetings for quality and meeting the unique needs of each city
 - Monitor deliverables and timeframe in order to produce quality plans within the required timeframe

SGVCOG HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION

HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION

Responds to cities inquiries

- A resource for subject matter expertise
- A quick answer source

Liaison between cities, the county and nonprofits

- Create a directory of nonprofits and cities primary homeless contact
- Help cities when having difficulties obtaining or understanding County responses
- Assist cities in coordinating and informing plans with mainstream systems: CES, CEO, DMH, DHS, DPH, LAHSA, HUD, State of California

SGVCOG HOMELESSNESS COORDINATION

Provide Technical Assistance and Training opportunities

- Coordinated LAHSA Data Mining technical assistance
- Coordinate and publicize County TA sessions

Regional Homeless Coordination

Facilitate subregional mini Continuums

- Formed respecting current organic and geographic relationships
- Analyze homeless population needs and service provision within each subregion

Provide cities with a united voice

- Anchor cities conferencing
- All cities policy and position input
- Create a position paper
- Coordinate with other LA County COGs
